Regina Public Library's Regent Place Branch is getting a new home

Regina Public Library Board Chair Darlene Hincks Joehnck is pleased to announce that the Regent Place Branch will be relocating to a new, larger location.

The new Branch will be two blocks south of the current location in the Market Mall on Albert Street.

"The lease at the current location ends on January 31 and the Board directed the Administration to review our situation and the marketplace to determine whether there were other options," said Hincks Joehnck. "The decision to relocate was based on what is best for RPL today and in the long-term future."

While the new location is being designed, the Regent Place Branch will serve the community from a temporary location -309 Albert Street - in the Market Mall.

Regina Public Library (RPL) is a non-profit, Board-run organization dedicated to enriching quality of life in Regina. For over 100 years, RPL has provided open access to materials, programs and services that encourage cultural, economic, educational and recreational development. RPL currently operates Central Library in downtown Regina, as well as eight Branch locations throughout the city, all of which play a key role in supporting the diverse cultures in our community.
