Saskatchewan eBooks Initiative

Included in the Board package is a backgrounder for the new Saskatchewan eBooks Initiative. Launched through the Multitype Library Board, the Saskatchewan eBooks Initiative will increase access to and raise the profile of Saskatchewan authors and publishers through digitization of Saskatchewan content. Seed money has been provided by the Ministry of Education and content will also be made available to people with visual disabilities through the National Network for Equitable Library Service (NNELS), another new service being launched soon.

Saskatchewan Integrated Library Systems (SILS) Consortium Update

The SILS Consortium and its member library systems, including RPL, will migrate to the newest integrated library system from Innovative Interfaces, Inc. (III). There will be relatively few changes to the user interface and staff interface, but the background workings of the system will change significantly and provide greater flexibility in adapting the system to specialized needs. The migration will take place over the Labour Day weekend.

The Consortium is also pleased to announce that Rob Zylstra will join the team as Executive Director starting on October 2nd. Rob is coming to SILS from MacEwan University in Edmonton where he is Campus Librarian for the Centre for the Arts & Communications. Before his work at MacEwan University, Rob was with the Yellowhead Regional Library, where he served as Technology Services Librarian and later as Client Services Manager. Combined with his strengths in leadership and management, Rob's immersion in technology will be a great asset to the SILS Consortium.
