Copy Short Strip (<=6 frames per strip) of Regular Color Film (135 format)

- 1. Log into the computer (S2).
- 2. Prepare the scanner.
 - a. Turn on the scanner (M2).
 - b. Pick up the right film template which contains
 - c. (Optional; This step is to clean the surface of template and film) Use pressurized duster
